<u>Who we are</u> – We are a group of property owners and recreational users of Tenmile Lakes focused on improving the water quality and recreational viability of Tenmile Lakes.

<u>What we stand for</u> – Clean Water! Whether you fish, swim, boat, or reside on our lakes clean water makes it better! We promote eco-friendly chemicals, cleaners, fertilizers and insecticides. Remember, anything chemical you use while a the lake will eventually get into the lake!

<u>What we do</u> – We work closely with state and local agencies involved with the management of the Tenmile Lakes watershed. We participate in local events and projects to promote responsible lake use. Here are some of our current projects we are involved in:

- Earth Day Lake Cleanup Our 2012 cleanup day was a huge success! Over 40 cubic yards of Lake and shoreline
 debris was collected and removed from our lakes by our volunteers! This annual event is a partnership with
 Oregon's SOLV-IT Program. SOLV is a non-profit organization focused on cleaning up Oregon's natural spaces
 and removing non-native invasive species.
- Tenmile Canal Dredging The TLOA and the Tenmile Lakes Basin Partnership have been actively working to dredge our canal that joins north and south lakes. Dredging this highly used passage is critical to maintaining the recreational use of our lakes.
- Weed Control The non-native invasive weeds are now the dominant water vegetation in Tenmile Lakes. The
 TLOA supports environmentally friendly weed abatement/removal programs. Our hope is to find a balanced,
 realistic weed management plan that improves water quality and usability without chemically killing the lake.
- County Park development Continuing to improve our county park recreational use and development is important to us. Soon Tenmile Lakes will have Oregon's first boat spray off station at a fresh water lake. This will be a frontline defense against more invasive species that hitch a ride on boats and watercraft.
- And much, much more.
